Safety and security ranks #1 in law enforcement priorities and the new LAPD Northeast station recognizes concrete masonry as the major interior and exterior building material to satisfy this need.

Breaking from the tradition of a standard masonry unit, the design included a 'sloped' textured unit which was a challenge in both manufacture and installation. By collaboration, the material producer and contractor were able to adjust the material composition and field-finish the masonry units to provide the desired finished product. Such collaboration shows the versatility of masonry. Sloped face units also provided a challenge at intersecting corners, which was solved with dimension adjustments. Interior jail cell walls are standard grey masonry units with a safety conscious epoxy finish.

In addition to such a unique finish, this facility also earned a LEED® Silver rating.
