California has a rich history of Spanish style architecture and keeping the tradition was the design of the new Holy Trinity Church in the Ladera Ranch community of Orange County. The goal was not to build a modern-looking church, but to construct a safe, contemporary church with the historic ambiance.

Masonry adorns the Spanish stucco style architecture at the pronounced entry with large Glass Fiber Reinforced Concrete units. The arched entry design invites parishioners into the sanctuary where windows are also designed in arching geometry. On the exterior, cast stone provides a complementary window finish.

Holy Trinity Church is an example of masonry appeal beyond typical clay brick and concrete block units where new masonry elements are used as depicted in history.
